- Kindergarten Orientation This Tuesday, 1/11/16. Parents will attend an information session in the library whist new students will join this year's Kindergarten students for classroom activities with Mrs Porteous. If projected numbers are realised, Mrs Porteous will take Kindergarten next year.
- Mrs Brown will be taking leave next year and Mr Dion Lalor will replace her.
