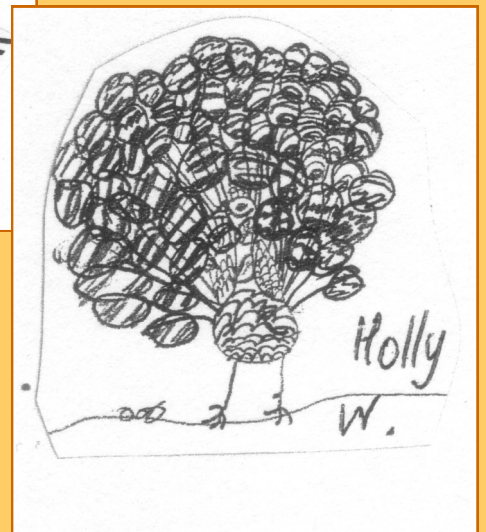
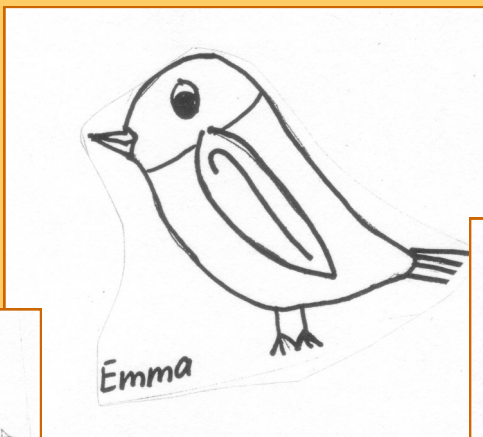
ARLD and CRL GROUP 7 RUGBY LEAGUE CLINIC - JANUARY SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

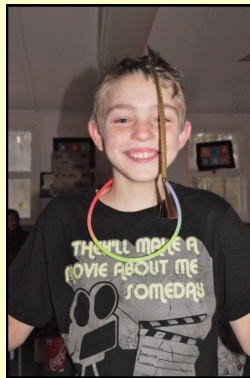
