PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Due to the tragic accident recently at Banksia Road Public School I am mindful of our staff car park and the safety of our students. Some parents are using the car park to drop off and pick up children before, during and after school. **Please DO NOT use the staff car park** under any circumstances unless given permission for one off use in an emergency. I have also passed this information on to the Preschool. Students who catch the bus to and from school must walk through the carpark making the risk of accidental injury much higher. I would also like to remind parents and carers that children are great imitators and will follow their footsteps when crossing the road. Please use the designated crossing to **cross safely** and reinforce this behaviour with all children of our school.

Through the self-evaluation process, we have been evaluating what we do well and what we need to work on next as we plan our directions for the next three years. We value your input and would like to know what you want Falls Creek Public School to look like in 2020. Parents and community members are invited to an **open discussion on Thursday 30th November at 5:15pm**. Please join us to let us know what's important to you and help shape the future of our beautiful school.

Our wonderful students have surpassed **10 000 Dojo points** for the year and we are rewarding them with a **Fun Colour Run** next Tuesday 28 November. The obstacle course will run from 9:30 to 11:00am. Please join us for this celebration and stay for a picnic recess/lunch in our playground.

Awards include Awesome/Dojo slips, merit awards, principal awards and dojo certificates (it does not include birthday or lost tooth certificates). Anything that is dated 2017 counts.

Our **2017 Presentation Assembly** will be held Wednesday 13 December. This year, the assembly will start at 12:45 following an early lunch at 12pm. Student reports will be handed out at the end

of this assembly. We apologise if holding the assembly during the day is inconvenient for some parents, however, it was necessary to accommodate staff family commitments. As a working parent, I do understand how difficult it can be to arrange time off and I know it is upsetting to not be able to make it (I miss all of my children's assemblies and fun school events). We hope that we have given you enough notice to be able to make suitable arrangements in order to attend. We will of course take many photos and share them with those that are unable to attend.

As we are nearing the end of term, we are busily preparing for the new school year. Please assist us to prepare by letting us know if you know of people who are moving to the area or if you intend leaving Falls Creek in 2018. We have more Kindergarten students enrolled to start school than the number of Year 6 students leaving, but it will not be quite enough to form three classes. It has been lovely to see next year's Kindy students feeling excited about coming to big school with some even wearing their school uniform. **Thank you, Ms Cullen** for coordinating the transition visits.






THAT'S A WRAP!




SAVE THE DATE - 1 NOVEMBER 2018
