NAPLAN: Grades 3 and 5 are participating in NAPLAN testing this week, commencing on Tuesday and concluding on Thursday. Good luck students.

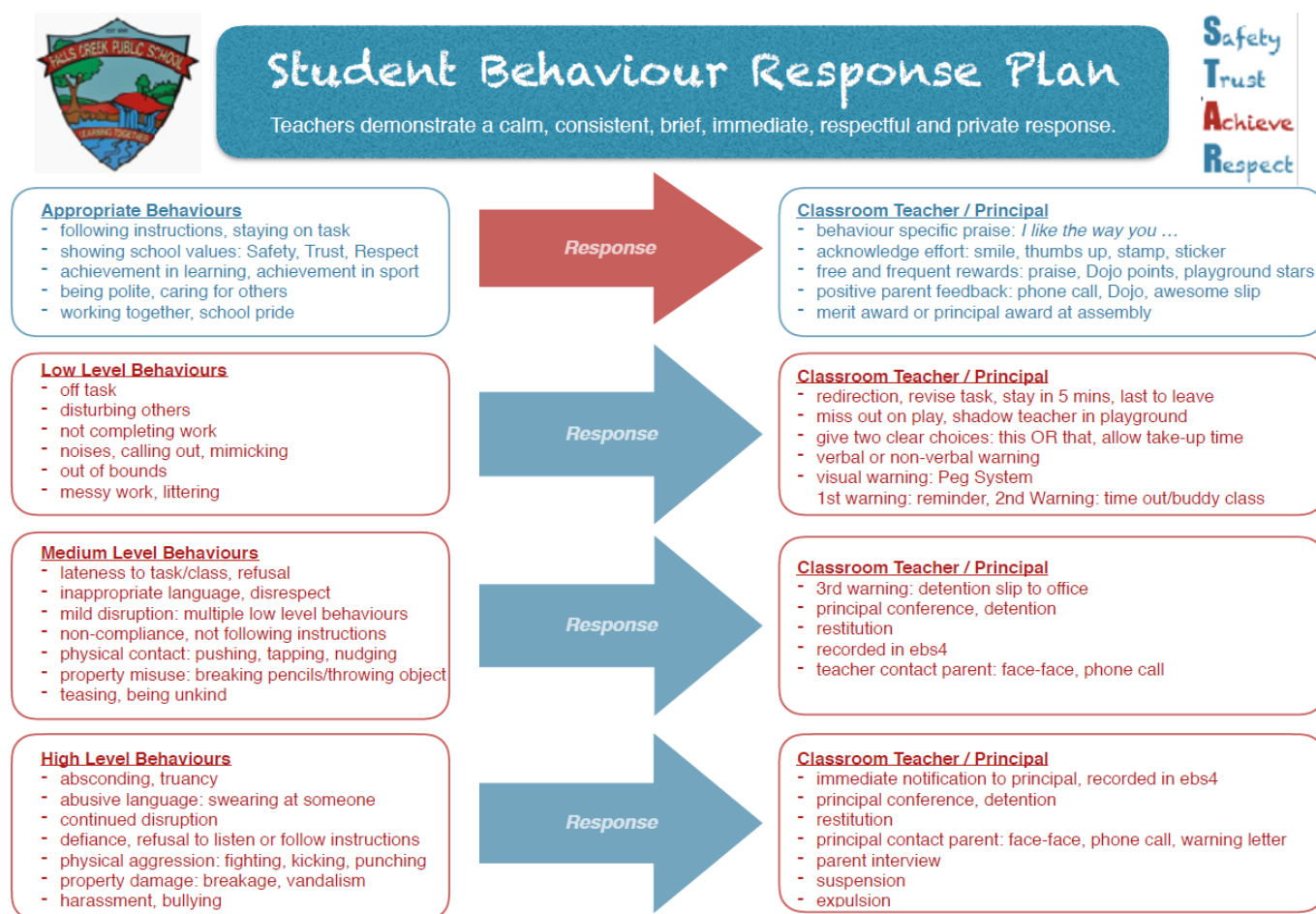

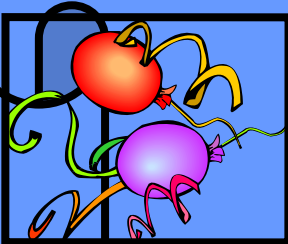

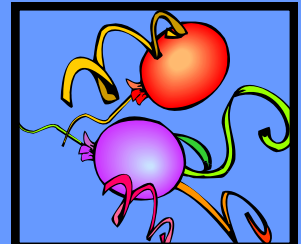
