#### Djiriba Waagura

This week local group Djiriba Waagura started an eight week program at Falls Creek. Joel and Robert will come in on Tuesdays to teach us about the land we're on. Each week will have a new focus. Today we learned about the smoking ceremony, its purpose and when it is used. The students enjoyed the sessions, especially eating some native bush cherries! #### A visit from Royal Far West to offer support:

A small team of 2-3 clinicians from Royal Far West (RFW), including a mix of Social Workers, Occupational Therapists, Speech Therapists and Psychologists, will be visiting our school from Monday 9 November to Friday 13 November, providing a range of information and support activities as part of their Bushfire Recovery Program. This includes the offer of:

- A small group program for students (Stormbirds) which helps with experiences of 'change & loss'. Places in the group are limited; however the learnings will be used to benefit all children. We are currently recommending students for the group, so please look out for the Consent Form & Brochure if your child has been recommended.
- Support & information session to parents/carers, in conjunction with the Shoalhaven Recovery Support

Service. This session will be held at **5.30pm on Wednesday 11th November**, at the school, and will provide information around supporting your child/family following the bushfires and in preparation for the summer season. Information on local services will also be provided. Due to COVID, numbers may need to be limited so please contact the school to express interest in attending.

- Support to school staff who play an important role in helping students and the broader school community with recovery.

The Clinicians from RFW will be following all the COVID-19 policies, procedures and advice from Health and Education during their visit. We are looking forward to having the RFW team join us.


